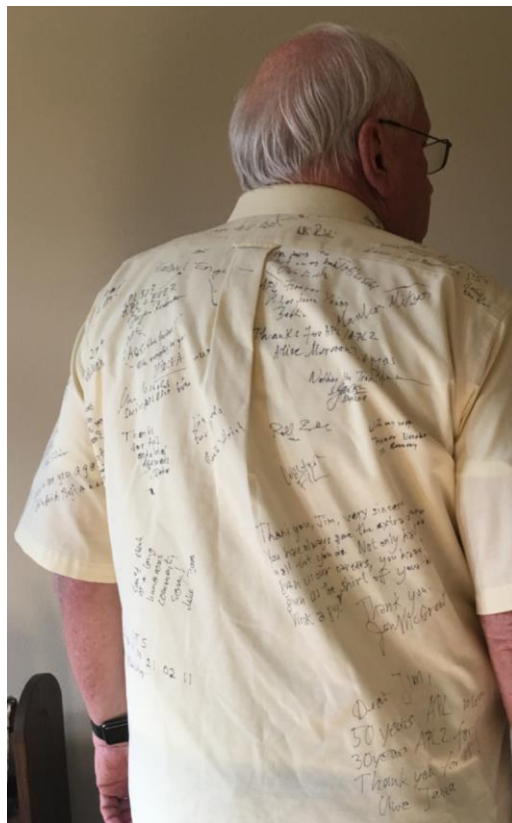


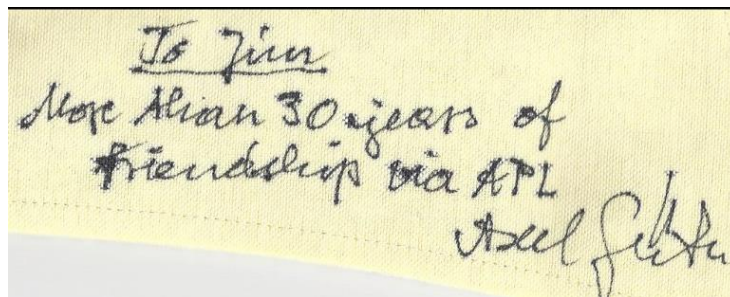
APL Shirt Version 2.0

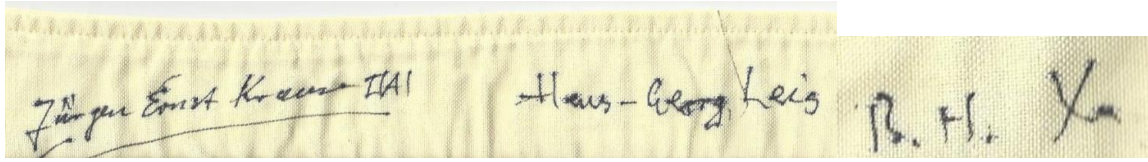

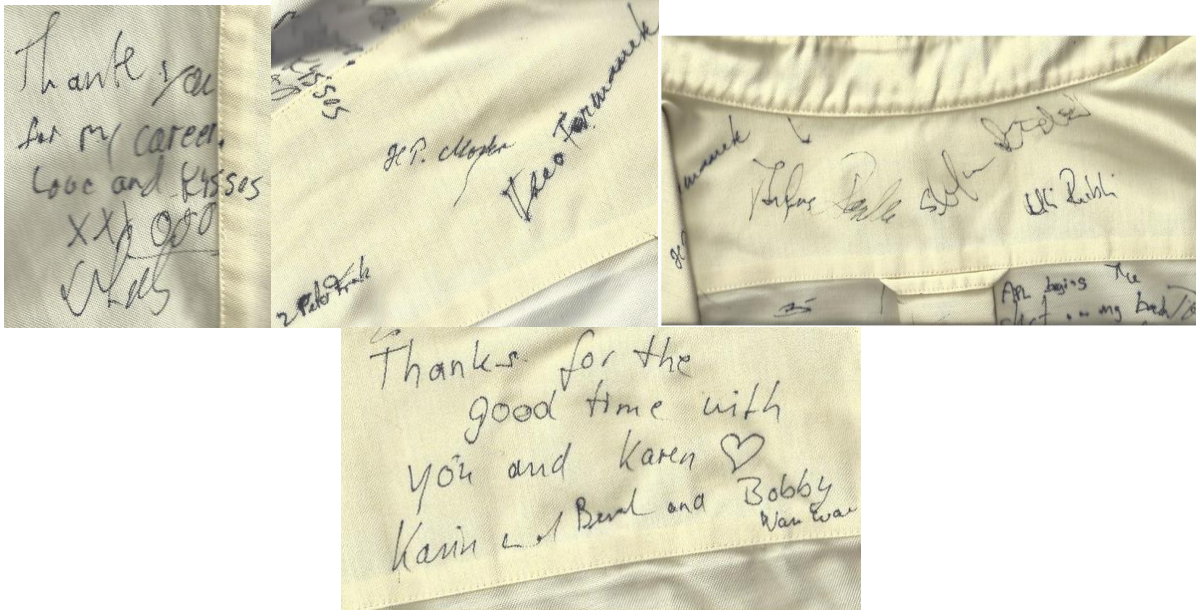
Outside Collar



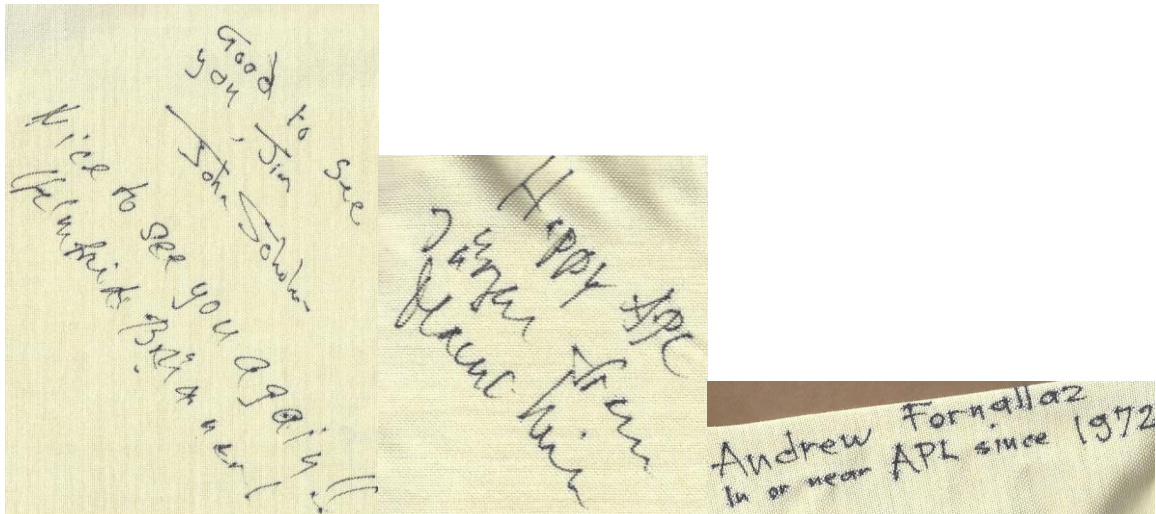
Inside Collar



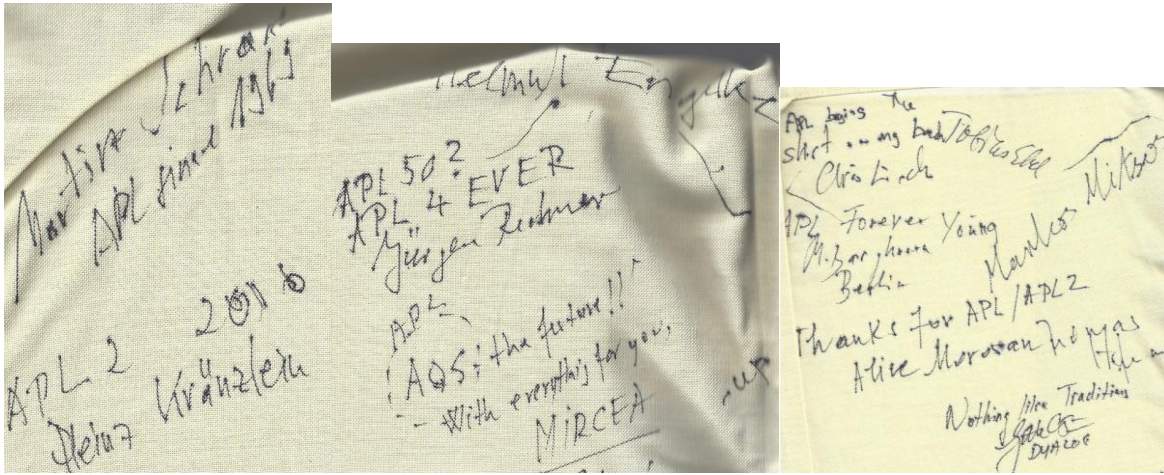
Below Collar



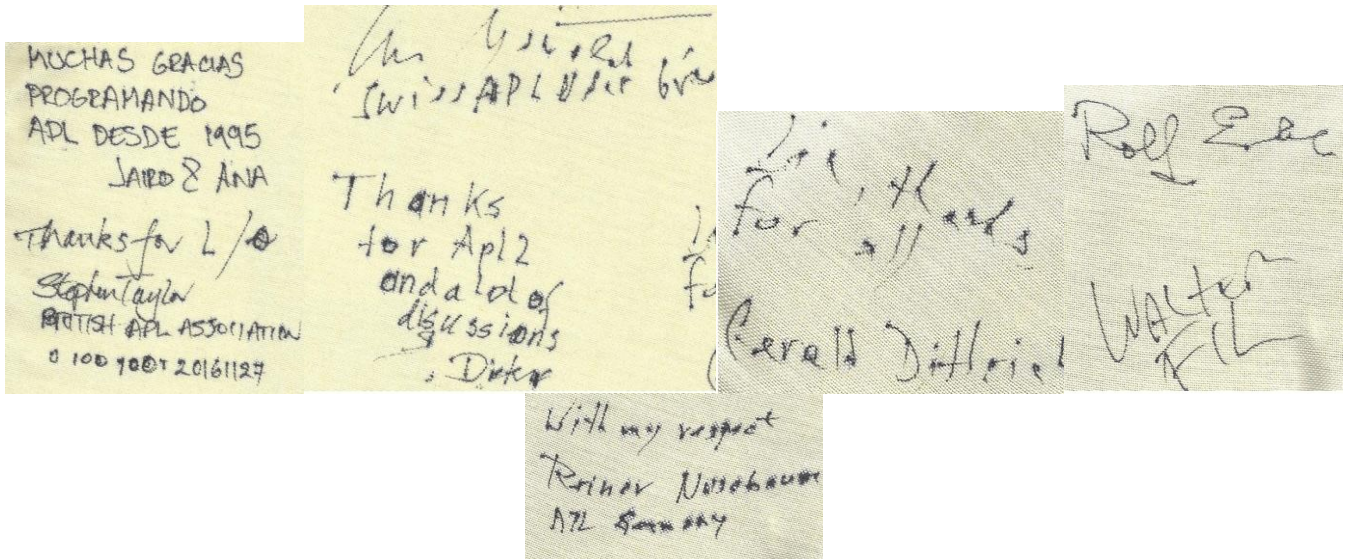
Left Sleeve



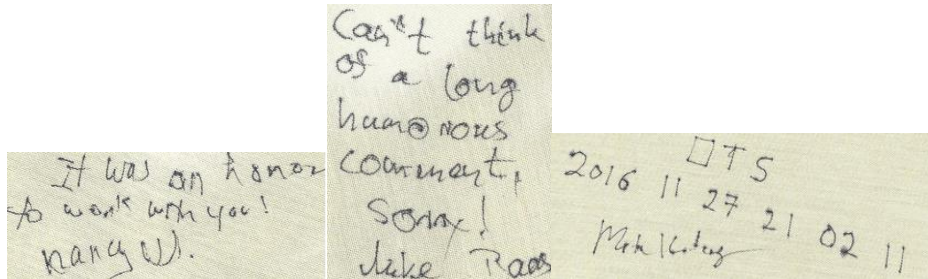
Between Sleeves
